
THETA Doradztwo Techniczne Tomasz Gendek as advisor to Warter Fuels SA, the supplier of the product "Smoke Oil" kindly informs that based on the data provided to us by the component manufacturer, the product isn't dangerous for the environment.

According to the CLP Regulation criteria, the product is not classified as dangerous to the environment. Both substances, interchangeably included in the product, i.e: C18-C50 branched, linear and cyclic hydrocarbons - distillates (CAS No. 848301-69-9) and white mineral oil (petroleum) (CAS number 8042-47-5) are registered in accordance with the requirements of REACH regulations, and simultaneously tested for environmental hazards:

The product is also not classified as a PBT substance (persistent, biodegradable and toxic) or vPvB (very persistent and highly biodegradable) in accordance with the criteria of Annex XIII of the REACH Regulation.
